



New Supports for kinship care youth: Effective Thursday, April 4, 2024, expanded eligibility for the Strengthening Abilities and Journeys of Empowerment program (SAJE).

SAJE now includes young adults from any legal care status, including those in kinship care, and those who have spent 24 or more cumulative months in care, even if they are no longer in care when they turn 19.

Young adults from all legal care statuses are eligible for SAJE supports, including youth with a permanent transfer of custody or those who are adopted between the ages of 12 and 19, or those who spent 24 months cumulative time in care between the ages of 12 and 19 or were in a comparable arrangement under Indigenous law.

More than 9,000 current and former youth in care will get more support as they enter adulthood

A new unconditional income support of \$1,250 per month is now available to former youth in care from age 19 to 20 to assist with living costs, such as groceries, daily travel expenses and rent.

When a young adult turns 20, they can choose to maintain the monthly payments until the age of 27 by participating in eligible programming, such as post-secondary education, life skills, rehabilitative, cultural or vocational training. <u>Learn more about SAJE here.</u>
